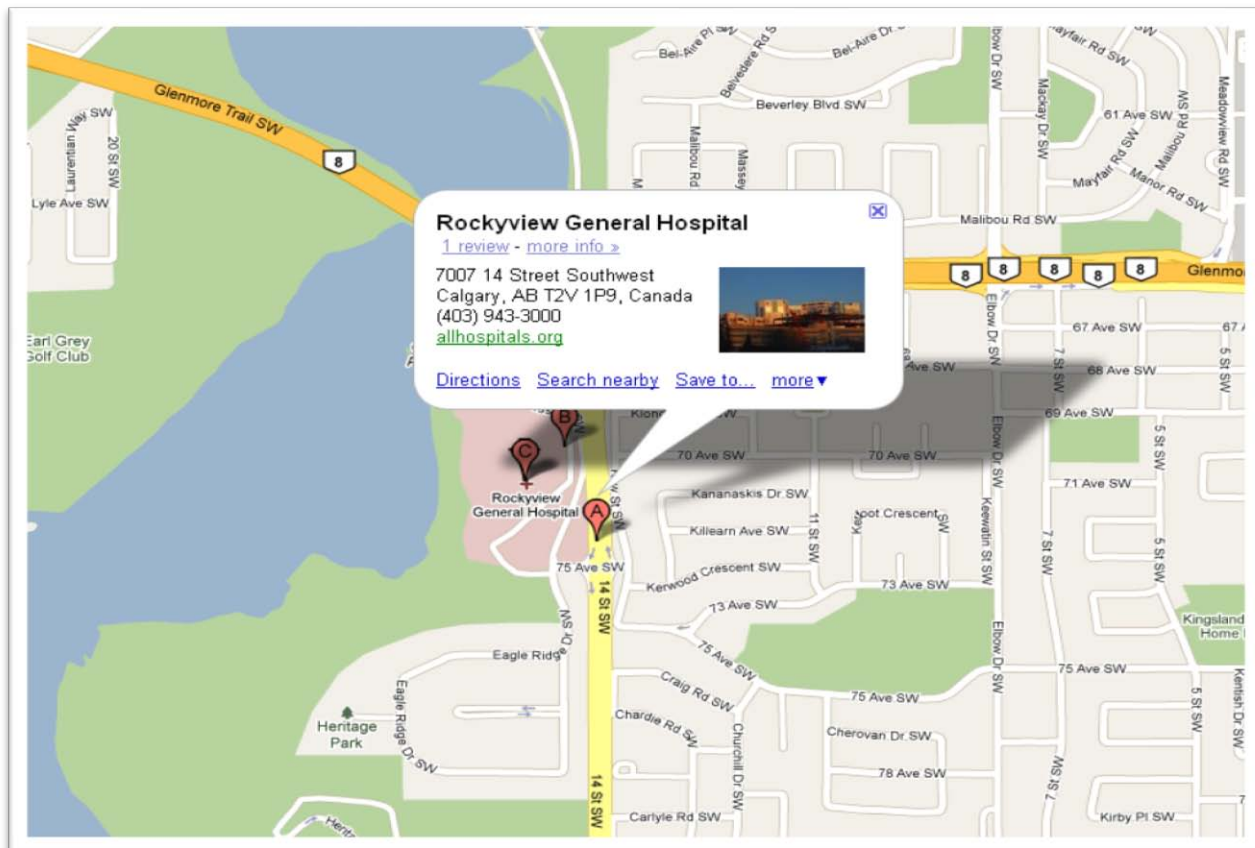

The new South Health Campus, a 155,000 square metre facility now being built in south Calgary will combine leading edge health care with the latest in technology, research and education in environment that focuses on providing a healthy, healing atmosphere for patients and staff. Completion of the initial phase is tentatively scheduled for 2011. Inpatient beds and an Emergency Department will improve access to round-the-clock hospital care.
