HELIOS UCMG POST FELLOWSHIP AWARDS

Awards up to \$80,000 are available to eligible physicians who:

- Will have completed their PGME training by June 2019
- Are pursuing further advanced clinical or scholarly training to enhance their skills post residency at another institution
- Plan to return to Calgary on completion of training to practice medicine, have a full time or clinical faculty appointment and be a member of UCMG to enhance the expertise within our community

The application is initiated by a Department Head who will provide:

- A completed cover sheet (<https://bit.ly/2Ppz36D>)*
- A letter from the applicant describing the training they will be undertaking and any funding available for that training*
- A copy of the applicant's CV*
- A letter supporting the applicant and confirmation the Department will provide matching funding to a Helios UCMG Post Fellowship Award

* Applicants are asked to submit these documents to Angela Hunter at angela.hunter@ahs.ca by **WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 9, 2019** to allow sufficient time for the Department's letter of support to be written.

Alberta Innovates Clinician Fellowship



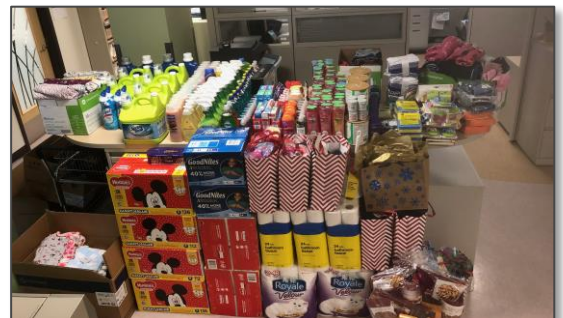
The Department is pleased to announce that Dermatology Resident Dr. Ryan Lewinson has received an Alberta Innovates

AMENDED HEALTH SERVICES BILLING CODES

03.05JB – amended to read as follows:

03.05JB Formal, scheduled family conference relating to a specific patient, per 15 minutes or major portion thereof

NOTE: 1. May not be claimed at the same encounter as **a visit**.
2. May be claimed to a maximum of 12 calls or **3** hours per year (April 1 to March 31), per patient, per physician.

03.05JR – Note 1 amended to read as follows:

03.05JR Physician telephone call directly to patient, to discuss patient management / diagnostic test results

NOTE: 1. A maximum of **14** telephone calls per physician, per calendar week may be claimed.

03.01S – Note 7 amended to read as follows:

03.01S Physician to patient secure electronic communication

NOTE: 7. A maximum of **fourteen** 03.01S per calendar week per physician may be claimed.

03.03FA – Note 2 amended as follows and skills added to Price List:

03.0FA Prolonged repeat office or scheduled outpatient visit in a regional facility, referred cases only, full 15 minutes or portion thereof for the first call when only one call is claimed.

NOTE: 2. May only be claimed by pediatrics (including subspecialties) and clinical immunology and allergy for patients 18 years of age and under, or by cardiology, endocrinology/metabolism, gastroenterology, infectious diseases, internal medicine, hematology, medical genetics, **medical oncology, neurology**, psychiatry, respiratory medicine, rheumatology, urology and vascular surgery (no age restriction).

SUBRATA GHOSH FELLOWSHIP AWARD

An annual award up to \$50,000 is available to:

- Residents currently enrolled in their final year of training (up to and including R5) in one of the Divisional training programs within the Department of Medicine in the Cumming School of Medicine
- Applicants must successfully complete their current training program prior to commencement of fellowship training
- Funding can only be obtained once per individual

Criteria for Selection:

- Aligns with the Department of Medicine's current Mission Statement, which is, *'To be widely recognized for advancing health and wellness, attracting the best doctors, leading innovation, creating technologies, and disseminating knowledge'*.
- Provides unique cutting-edge translational, clinical, or health outcomes research training not currently available or provided in Calgary;
- Shows strong potential for scholarly activity that can be applied upon returning to Calgary.

Application to include:

- **CV** (include current scholarly and leadership activities)
- 2 page **Letter of Intent** outlining
 - o Area of proposed fellowship training,
 - o Impact on the DoM/CSM,
 - o Intent to return,
 - o Potential sources of other funding
- Two **Letters of Support** (1-2 pages each): one letter from a senior divisional member or other relevant mentor and one letter from the current residency training program director outlining
 - o Area of proposed fellowship training and impact on Department,
 - o Academic and leadership potential

Message from David Keegan, Associate Dean, Faculty Development, Cumming School of Medicine

Dear Colleagues,

As you know, the University of Calgary has been working on configuring a system to replace the Academic Report Online (ARO). This new system is called Faculty 180 and will be part of what the university will be calling "Academic Portfolio."

There are many complex issues related to this transition. One of them is that our existing system, the ARO, has stayed open to enable faculty members to record their academic productivity. Many faculty members and/or their administrative assistants have entered data into the ARO for the current cycle. We have looked into converting and migrating data that is in the ARO into the Faculty 180 system. Unfortunately, this is not an easy thing and would require faculty members and their administrative supports to do a lot of work to "clean up" their data.

For this and other reasons, the following is the decision on how CSM will migrate to the new system.

1. We will **continue** to use the ARO for the current merit cycle (2017-2019).
2. The Faculty 180 system will be used by CSM faculty members for activities on or after July 1, 2019.

To make this work and ensure everyone gets the training they need, the following will occur:

1. The Office of Faculty Development (OFD) will offer training, support and open-house events to ensure faculty members and administrative personnel are able to use the ARO system effectively.
2. The Faculty 180 team will also be converting and migrating data that does so cleanly (i.e. with low risk of error) from ARO to Faculty 180 (for archival purposes) in the background.
3. OFD will also be working with the Faculty 180 team and the Administrative Services team to train administrative staff in the use of Faculty 180, so they can convert and migrate needed data from the ARO to Faculty 180. This will be particularly important for activities of AMHSP members in the April 1, 2019 to June 30, 2019 period, as this will assist with potential future financial year reporting.
4. CSM faculty member training in the use of Faculty 180 will commence in spring 2019, and will continue over the long term.
5. We (OFD) will be also focused on directly supporting you (department heads) and your administrative assistants to make sure you have the support and training you need.

We (OFD and the Faculty 180 team) will continue to communicate with you about the transition and training/support opportunities in the New Year.
