### 1. MD Recruitment:

Thank you to the many DOM members that attended the MEOC Webinar on March 27 and signed up to participate in our collective COVID pandemic response. If you missed the webinar it is now posted on UofC's eCME site (<https://ecme.ucalgary.ca/covid-19-cme-resources/acute-care/>).

We are working to develop tentative schedules that incorporate DOM members who volunteer to participate in our COVID-19 Pandemic response. DOM members will soon be invited to sign up for COVID teams, either as either a Pod LEAD or a Pod MD, based on acute care experience. Please fill out your availability as soon as possible. Signing up does not mean you will be deployed to direct patient care on COVID teams. Members can participate in many ways. We will reach out as soon as we can to let you know you are scheduled. Please keep yourself available for times you have signed up.

### 2. MD Training:

We are pleased to launch our mandatory safety certification course for PPE training for all MDs who provide COVID-19 care. Our training consists of three distinct components:

- **Part one** is an online module that is hosted within the eCME platform and is available now.
- **Part two** is an in-person PPE practice session using the buddy system.
- **Part three** is a simulation session and takes place immediately after #2. (beginning Apr 2,20)
